Motivational Interviewing

Working from an Evidence-Based Practice perspective, this Motivational Interviewing immersion will augment and enrich your existing MI knowledge base while building a stronger MI skill set. Participants will learn about the Motivational Interviewing Competency Assessment (MICA) as a structure for MI conversations and have multiple opportunities to apply MI with volunteer clients. The conversations will be recorded, coded with the MICA, then debriefed with coaching feedback to improve Motivational Interviewing skills.
