## Course Description

How do you help someone who is ambivalent about change? Originally developed to treat adults with substance use issues, Motivational Interviewing (MI) has evolved into a counseling approach that applies to multiple fields, and across cultural lines. MI emphasizes empathetic listening and techniques to empower client self-determination and positive action. In this two session, 11 hour training, participants will learn the foundations of MI and practice MI techniques.
