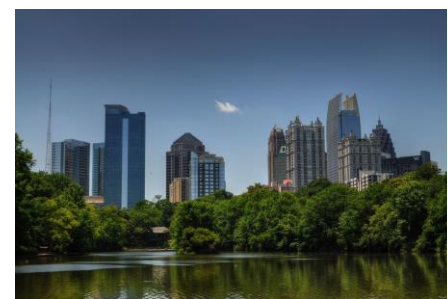
Forum Update
