The workshop will introduce a model of supervision that integrates MI principles and skills with the functions model of clinical supervision (Proctor 1986, 2009) to create MI adherent staff and clinical supervision model.

Demonstrate an understanding of the course's overview model of MI supervision including:

- The purposes of supervision
- The four functions of supervision
- Describe and discuss MI supervision
- Describe the role and qualities of an MI supervisor
- Evaluate the ethical and professional issues involved in the supervisory relationship and role.

Demonstrate developing self- awareness including:

- Explore their own motivation and needs as both supervisees and supervisors
- Explore the blocks to being a better supervisor, supporter and mentor
- Explore how to utilize their strengths to overcome possible blocks

Demonstrate the ability to use MI supervision skills including:

- Practise using the model's skills and strategies in role-play and real-play peer supervision situations.
- Use the model concepts and skills to develop positive and collaborative relationship with supervisees.
- Use the MI supervision concepts and skills to deal with difficult situations
